C	13-16	Above Average	This person demonstrates a fair degree of reasoning ability and would be quite competent at handling the types of tasks that might be encountered in straightforward financial assignments or statistical operations of medium complexity. 	0-4	Inferior	This individual does not appear to possess knowledge of basic mathematical concepts, and is not competent to handle the simplest operations. Assignments should not involve any numerical responsibilities.
